Providing investment management for United Methodist church funds since 2002

The funds we offer have a demonstrated 20+ year history of being suitable for church investments. What makes a fund suitable? The investment choices follow the United Methodist Social Principles and serve as a testimony to our faith. The funds are diversified with less concentration than indexes and have delivered competitive returns at a reasonable cost. Our strategy is to purchase securities based on their value for sustained long-term growth and protection in volatile periods.

Meeting the Obligation of a Fiduciary

The United Methodist Frontier Foundation Board of Directors serves as a fiduciary for the funds you entrust with us. Our semi-annual meeting with our investment advisors allows us to discuss the 5 "Ps" of good investment manager reviews.

People: We get to know the team.

Philosophy: We get to know the fundamental underpinning of value in their investment strategy.

Process: We get to know the process-oriented approach and whether it is repeatable.

Performance: We get to discuss the performance history.

Price: We examine our ability to provide a reliable, stable product at a reasonable price.
